Organization description

The Seattle Sephardic Network (SSN), open to all, engages in inspiring and informative programs celebrating the Sephardic culture in Seattle and beyond. We envision a Seattle Sephardic community that embraces the full dimension of Sephardic life, functioning in an always inclusive and coordinated manner. We strive to be a resourceful organization and community catalyst for encouraging and supporting Sephardic cultural awareness, exchange and expression. We also aim to support and augment Sephardic programs and activities already offered by existing institutions in Seattle and other communities, and to develop future programs, partnerships, resources, and educational and cultural initiatives that advance and promote deeper understanding of and celebrate Sephardic life in the region.

Position description

Summer 2023: Intern position involves event planning, program management, marketing, research, and potential graphic design work to support the programming and marketing efforts of the Seattle Sephardic Network and its volunteer board. Key functions include writing and communications skills, organizing event logistics, collaborating with SSN board president, board members and administrative assistant, assisting with marketing efforts, collateral materials creation, and program research.

Specific assignments would include some or all of the items below:

Event planning/program management

 - b. Ladino choir. Help research and/or coordinate launch with committee and director. This includes outreach to the community
 - c. Plan fall events with UW Hillel
 - d. Plan fall film event at Majestic Bay theater
 - e. Eshar Lashon quarterly community gatherings. Scope content, audience and venues
 - f. 2024 Boreka baking contest. Plan this event, to take place in Q4 2023 or 2024
 - *Some of these events will be held during summer 2023; others will be planned in advance, but held after summer internship ends. Internship could extend beyond the summer with agreement of intern and SSN board.
